APPLICATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Duquesne University's LLM is offered only to candidates who have already completed university-level legal studies in their home country and enrollment is limited to five LLM students per year. English language ability must meet or exceed the TOEFL examination score set for admission to the J.D. program. Generally a total TOEFL score of 600 paper/250 electronic is considered to be minimally acceptable.

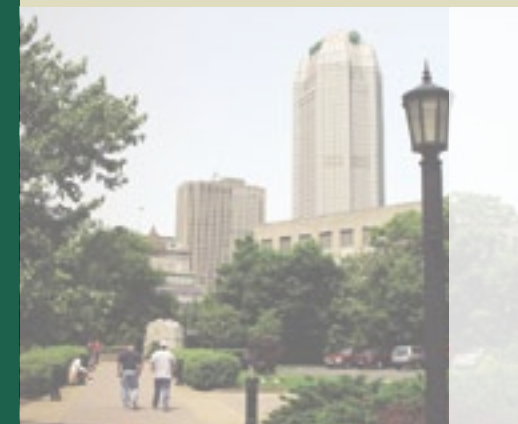

Why Pursue an LLM Degree at DUQUESNE UNIVERSITY?



Duquesne School of Law focuses on real-world experiences with Moot Court competitions and ample opportunity to participate in clinical programs and externships.



Located in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, Duquesne University's highly regarded School of Law is the ideal place to earn your LLM. Students can choose between a traditional day-time program, or a flexible evening program to allow days free for employment, internships or externships.

INDIVIDUALIZED ATTENTION

Duquesne's LLM is offered only to lawyers who have completed their university-level law study outside the United States or are authorized to practice law in a country or countries other than the United States. Enrollment in the program is limited to only five students per year to allow for individualized attention to each student. Duquesne also provides its foreign LLM students with private study and research areas in the Law Library, as well as ample no-cost access to state-of-the-art computers, on-line databases, and the Internet. LLM students receive personalized attention from law faculty who ensure that each individual student maximizes his or her learning potential.

COMFORTABLE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

International students find it easy to interact with the Law School's friendly community. The classroom is not the only place where students expand their knowledge. Whether it is mingling in the student lounge with a cup of coffee, joining one of the over twenty student organizations, or studying with a study group in the Center for Legal Information, students have many opportunities to learn about the United States' legal systems.

CURRICULUM

LLM candidates must complete a total of 28 credits. The curriculum features a selection of required core American law courses, plus a variety of eligible elective courses. Core courses include Legal Process and Procedure, Constitutional Law, Legal Research and Writing, and Civil Procedure. Among the electives are Contracts, Evidence, International Law, the Law of Corporations, and Negotiable Instruments. LLM students can also gain real-world experience through participation in Duquesne's clinics and externships.
