Problem of grammatical categorization in bamanankan: the case of fe

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The categorization of words poses a serious problem in Mandé generally and in bamanankan particularly. In the grammatical descriptions of the bamanankan the morpheme $f\varepsilon$ was always considered as a postposition in the same way as lá and kàn. But in practice it is easy to observe that $f\varepsilon$ has syntactical and morphological characteristics which bring it nearer to verbs. My intention is not to prove that $f\varepsilon$ is a verb, but simply to demonstrate the problem of categorization in bamanankan. Might it be possible that we deal with two $f\varepsilon$? In this contribution we shall try to propose answers.
