In ZPE 60, 1985, 10, I argued that at Ar. Pax 195 ἱηυ ἱηυ ἱηυ (P.Berol. 21223) is preferable to ἱῆ ἱῆ ἱῆ (codd.), and I suggested that ἱηῦ ἱηῦ should be restored also at Vesp. 1335 (ἱῆ ἱεῦ codd.).

By chance I have noticed that this interjection, unknown to LSJ, is attested by Herodian, who accents it oxytone: Καθολικὴ προαιδία I 506.20 Lentz (restored from Theognost. Can. p. 161.9) τὸ ἰύ, ὃ λέγεται καὶ ἱηύ, ὀξύνόμενον καθαρεύει ἐπὶ θαύματος κείμενον.
