A CATALOG OF DUPLICATE PAPYRI

This article makes available as a research tool an extensive, annotated list of papyri found in more than one copy. It is one part of a work in progress and I would be grateful for any corrections, additions or comments. They will help refine my work in regard to the myriad of questions that spring from such material.¹

Collected in this catalog are all those documents primarily from Ptolemaic and Roman Egypt for which more than one copy are extant. These documents were written in more than one copy for a variety of reasons: some were drafts, some were duplicates, some were copies. We exclude only multiple copies of rescripts, apokrimata, edicts, and collections of edicts and epistles. The excluded documents were all, to a greater or lesser extent, meant to have wide circulation achieved presumably through publication of copies,² and as such performed the same function as the “publication” by means of multiple inscriptions.³

There are two groups of documents which though similar to those collected are in fact quite different: 1) multiple private letters written on a single sheet of papyrus, 2) “false” duplicates. The first group of documents are private letters and were never intended to carry any legal or binding force.⁴ In the second group of documents not included in the catalog, though the text or body of the document may be identical, each “copy” stands as a separate legal agreement and neither one authenticates nor verifies the other.⁵ Among many of the papyri which belong to this group one of a pair seems to, or may be understood to, stand as an exemplar for the other.

The doppelurkunde is a special case because, according to the standard understanding, the inner and outer texts were both necessary and were intended to stay together for authentication.⁶ It might seem at first glance that such authentication would obviate the need for more than one copy. However, *P.Yad.* 25.66- 67 and 26.20 both include the statement that ἀντίτυπα δύο “two copies were written”, and in 23.23-24 it seems clear that the phrase ἔχουσιν δὲ ἑκάτεροι ἀντίτυπον “both parties have a copy”, should be understood to mean that two copies of the doppelurkunde were written. An equivalent phrase is found in several doppelurkunden from Dura Europos (*P.Dura* 18.30-31 (87), 19.17-18 (88/9), 22.15 (133/4) and 32.18 (254)), written in Greek ἔχει δὲ καὶ ἀντισύγγραφον “it is executed in double copy”, and even one written in Syriac (*P.Dura* 28 (243)) “Two documents of this sale have been written: one copy retained for record in the archive ... the other in possession of the buyer”. The corpus of doppelurkunden from Egypt preserves an equivalent phrase, κατατέθειται τὸ ἀντίγραφον ἐν τῇ βιβλιοθήκῃ *P.Adler* G5.ii.12 (Thebaid, 108 BCE), a two column document with its seal still attached, and in fact the corpus contains several doppelurkunden in more than one copy. While we will not supplement lists of doppelurkunden we will include in the catalog of duplicate papyri those doppelurkunden for which evidence of more than one copy is extant.⁷

Guide to the Catalog

Papyrological editions are cited according to the abbreviations in the fourth edition of *A Checklist of Editions of Greek and Latin Papyri, Ostraca and Tablets*, edited by J.F. Oates, W.H. Willis, R.S. Bagnall, and K.A. Worp (Atlanta, 1992). The language of all the papyri is Greek unless otherwise indicated in the first column.

In the column labelled “**Photo**”, the following symbols are employed:

- x photographs of each text are published in the ed. pr. (if the duplicates are in separate corpora, an x means that the photograph of each one appears ad. loc.);
- o a photograph of only one of the texts is published (if the duplicates are from the same corpus the appropriate number is indicated), if the photograph appears elsewhere than the ed. pr. its location is given in the column labelled “comments”.

In the **date** column, all dates are CE unless otherwise indicated.

The column labelled “**Nature**”, refers to the physical description of the duplicates. Were they written on one sheet of papyrus and remain as uncut, were they written on one sheet but cut in antiquity, were they written on separate sheets but joined?

The column labelled “**Hands**”, indicates if the duplicates were written in the same hand. Where necessary, brief comments about changes of hand are made in the “**Comments**” column.

The column labelled “**DG**”, for δισσὸν γραφέν or a similar phrase, indicates whether or not, and if yes in which line(s), there is internal evidence that the document was written in more than one copy.

To the extent possible critical work on papyri is cited by *BL* volume and page, otherwise it is cited in full. Full publication information for citations in the comments can be found in the bibliography.
